“At the beginning of the job there were some challenges, which caused progress to move slowly. After things were discussed and sorted, considerable progress began. The OCS crew was soon able to make first entry into the vessel to begin the cleanout. Observing the amount of solids internally, anticipation for the cleaning was estimated to take four days. Fortunately, the crew completed the cleaning of the vessel and the bridles in two and a half days. This also included disassembly, inspection and reassembly of the bridles. This high level critical work of a hydrocarbon confined space with such tight and awkward compartments was performed safely with no incidents or accidents reported. In addition to that, the crew did a remarkable job in cleaning the vessel thoroughly, especially in the hard to reach spots they encountered. I personally confirmed this by entering the vessel to perform a final inspection.



Once the OCS crew was finished, the construction crew was prompted to assist in the re-connection of the piping and flanges. They reviewed the task at hand and went right to work completing the job in a safe and timely manner.”


